


Organizes Faculty Development Program(FDP) on Cyber Security and Big Data Analytics

Big data can be defined as an environment where volume, velocity and variety of data exceed the organization's storage or computing power for interpreting an accurate useful information for timely decision making. Every computer, laptop, tablet, mobile phone and other mobile devices connected to network represents a vulnerable end point as hackers are constantly and continually attacking companies, banks, government offices, universities and others. These hackers are writing malicious code to exploit websites and our networks. Some of these malicious software include viruses, worms, spyware, rootkits trojan horses and many other malicious software. These attacks disrupt our operations and try to gain access to proprietary data and personal information. Further global availability of mobile wireless internet raises a number of questions and concerns to be answered by today's stakeholders and decision makers. A number of initiatives to address cyber security, various activities common threat reporting, policy guidance, cyber space laws in addition to providing cyber security. Big data and analytics is showing promise with improving cyber security.
