
CSI NATIONAL SEMINAR

Fatehgarh Sahib is a historically important city for the Sikh faith. Gurudwara Fatehgarh Sahib, marks the site of live entombment of the two younger sons of the tenth Guru of the Sikhs, Sri Guru Gobind Singh on 12th December 1705 by the Governor of Sirhind, Wazir Khan. The place is today commemorated by Gurudwara Fatehgarh Sahib, 5 km in the north of Sirhind.

The town is surrounded by four memorial gates, each built in the memory of four important persons from the Sikh history associated with Sirhind. These a .: Deewan Todar Mal. Nawab Sher Mohd, Khan, Baba Banda Singh Bahadur and Baba Moti Ram Mehra. All belonged to different castes in religions, thus depicting the harmony and brotherhood among the people of those times.

The city is also known for a number of saints, scholars, poets, historians, calligraphers and scribes, who lived here. It has also been home to 16th-century saint of the Naqshbandi order, 'Ahmad Sirhindi' (1564-1624), whose mausoleum, the Rauza Sharif is also situated in Fatehgarh Sahib.
